Step 1, relax...

In a Pew Study* of 1,364 four-year U.S. colleges (aka almost all of them)...

- 17 schools admitted fewer than 10% of applicants. Harvard, Stanford, Yale, Northwestern, etc.
- Another **29 schools admitted between 10% and 20%**. Georgetown, USC, UCLA, Berkeley, etc.
- These "Extremely Competitive" schools make up 3.4% of schools, and 4.1% of total student enrollment.
- On the other hand, more than **700 schools admitted 67% or more** of their applicants. Virginia Tech, St. John's, Missouri, Quinnipiac, Arizona, George Mason, Ohio State, etc.







3 Approaches to giving them what they want (while still showing who YOU are):

Approach #1 – Be Impressive

Any old kid can get good grades in college, graduate, and get a job. Counselors want to find bigger fish who will MAKE WAVES. Their jobs depend on it.

- Suggest what big things you'll do on campus, or out in the world. "My First Play"

Approach #2 – Be Different

Colleges don't just want butts in chairs. They want all types of students. Diversity.

- Suggest what makes you different than all the other hard-working, good-grade-getting students out there. "The Twin Who Un-Twinned"

Approach #3 – Be Interesting

Counselors have to read a lot of these essays. Make them remember you.

- Use stories, detailed examples... - Be funny, touching, dramatic, whatever fits your topic, but don't use a gimmick that isn't you. "The Basement"
